At Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi, the Equal Opportunity Cell/Enabling Unit is diligently working to empower students with disabilities. The unit's primary goal is to provide necessary amenities for disabled students within the college library and across the campus.

To support visually impaired students, the unit has granted Braille library memberships to five students: **Manpreet Singh (B.A. Programme I Year)**, **Nishant Singh (B.A. (Hons.) Political Science I Year)**, **Aarush Dewan (B.A. Programme II Year)**, **Rahul Kumar (M.A. Hindi II Year)**, and **Roshan Thakur (M.A. Hindi II Year)**. Additionally, these students have been provided with Angel India devices and laptops, among other aids. The reading hall is equipped with audio-visual devices and internet access to facilitate comfortable reading and listening experiences for students with disabilities.

Furthermore, **Help the Blind Foundation, Hong Kong (HTBF)** recently disbursed a scholarship totaling **₹30,000 (₹10,000 each)** to three visually impaired students of the college on **24 January 2024**. The scholarship recipients are **Manpreet Singh (B.A. Programme I Year)**, **Rahul Kumar (M.A. Hindi II Year)**, and **Bharat Kumar (B.A. Programme I Year)**.

In addition to these initiatives, the college has installed steel Braille signage to assist visually impaired students in navigating the campus. Reserved parking spaces for differently-abled individuals have also been designated, enhancing accessibility within the college premises. These measures have significantly improved campus accessibility and inclusivity for students with disabilities.
