Annual Gender Sensitization Report 2021-2022


"Achieving gender equality requires the engagement of women and men, girls and boys. It is everyone's responsibility." — Ban Ki-moon

Gender sensitization is the process of creating awareness regarding gender equality issues and modifying the behaviour and views that people hold about themselves and other genders. This process helps in examining people's "personal attitudes and beliefs and questioning the 'realities' they thought they know."

The Women Development Cell of Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College organised a training workshop on 21st September 2021 at 11 a.m. on: **Stand-up Against Street Harassment** by speaker Uzma, Certified Trainer, Hollaback Foundation via zoom. The event was inaugurated by the honourable principal of the college, Professor Gyantosh Kumar Jha. The convenor of the Women Development Cell, Shibani Phukan, gave an overview of the topic of the workshop. Then, Preeti Jain, one of the members of the WDC, introduced the speaker Uzma from Breakthrough Trust. 74 participants attended the event. Following the introduction, Uzma talked about the campaigns by Hollaback Foundation. The talk turned into a lively discussion on topics like 'What includes in Street Harassment?', 'Impacts of Street Harassment', etc. The speaker enlightened the audience on 'Bystander Intervention: A proven methodology'. She also talked about how one can help women who face street harassment and how to empower oneself against the same. She made the session interactive through scenario based questions. Thereafter, the speaker took up questions from the curious audience. The program was concluded by a heartfelt vote of thanks given by Dr. Syed Mubin Zehra.


