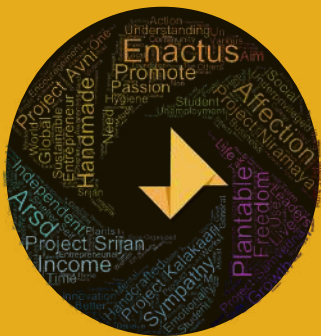

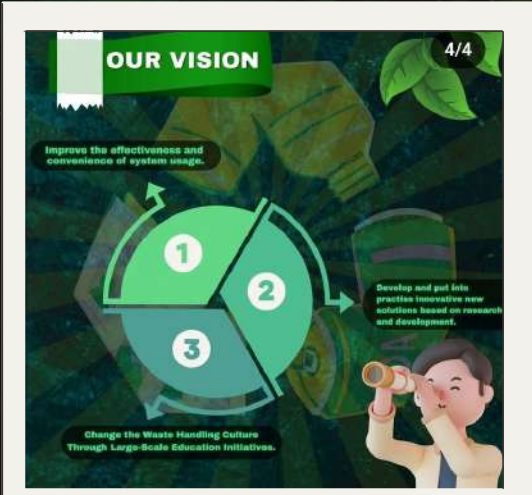

For the inauguration of Utkarsh, we launched several new products and hampers, for example- minion hampers which included minion-themed pots, bookmarks, totes, rakhis, soft toys, etc

3). INDEPENDENCE DAY 10

VISIT WITH DEEP BLIND WELFARE ASSOCIATION



Enactus ARSD believes in contributing to the growth and development of this nation by empowering the underprivileged section of society. With this vision in mind, team Enactus under project Samvedna visited the DEEP BLIND WELFARE FOUNDATION to celebrate 75 years of independence (AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV) on 13th August 2022. Our team celebrated Independence Day with blind Children and distributed sweets. We also met the general secretary of the foundation Ms Nirmal who herself is a blind woman working for the welfare of blind children.

4). SANJAY VAN CLEANING DRIVE

Sanjay Van Cleanup Drive was organised in association with "There is no EarthB" at Sanjay Van, Vasant Kunj on 21st August 2022. 12 members of our team volunteered for the program and helped to collect, along with 13 independent volunteers, 109.5 kg of waste from that area. The program was a great learning experience for the team and we hope to participate in more events like these in the future



5).UTKARSH 2.0



The second monthly Utkarsh saw us visiting Unity One Mall, Janakpuri, a popular location among stall-setters. We organised the event on 27th August 2022, starting from noon and continuing till 10 pm. We launched a variety of products including our new-and-improved embroidered and printed tote bags with designs ranging from 'F.R.I.E.N.D.S.' to Zodiac signs and inspired by the famous artist, Van Gogh. Tote bags also had the option of customisation. The launch also featured a collaboration with the Deep Blind Welfare Association for the production of incense sticks and dhoop cones and Pixellation, the photography society of ARSD college for the event's photography. Further, another product launched was 'bookmarks' on the themes of 'Harry Potter', 'Minions', 'Anime' and our favourite 'Coffee'. Project Srijan also launched a 'Grow Your Own Food' campaign introducing seeds of peas, eggplants, capsicum, tomatoes, coriander, chilli, french beans, radish and coriander! In all this event was a great success, which was accomplished only due to the continuous guidance and motivation of our teachers.

PANEL DISCUSSION

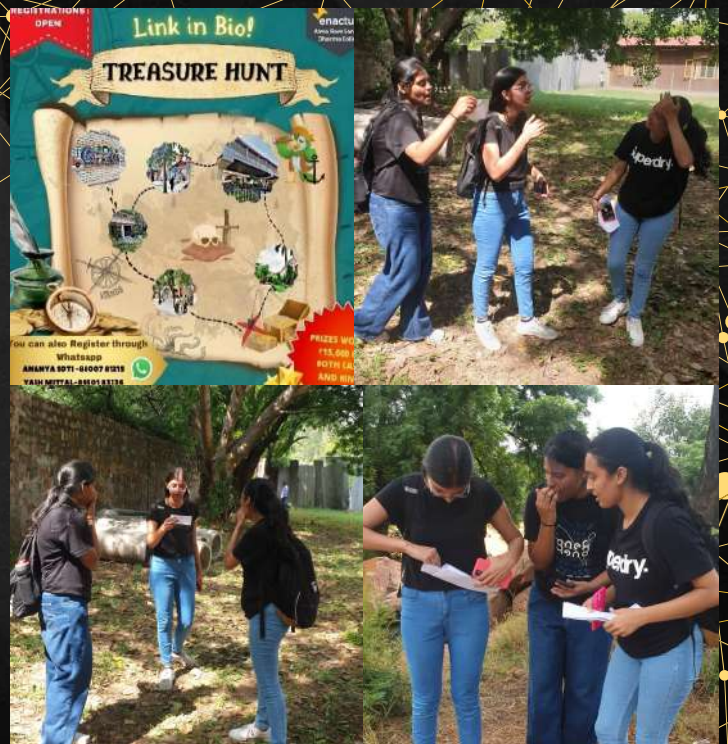

They demonstrated how a used t-shirt might be transformed into a practical cloth bag. It was followed by a pitching session where they could showcase and sell their bags to the judges. The winner of this segment was awarded Rs. 1500.

7). POTTERY WORKSHOP

Team Enactus ARSD visited Potter's community in Uttam Nagar on 15th September 2022. The participants explored a completely different field from the conventional ones. Everyone was ecstatic when they met the workers of the pottery community. The attendees were keen and listened to their accounts of how the community was set up and how different generations had participated in the same activity. The benefits of using "Mitti Ke Bartan" over steel or glass crockery were also emphasized. Enactus ARSD recruitment for the year 2022-23 started with the form-filling round on 22 July 2022, the deadline of which was 15 August 2022, 12 pm. The first round was cleared by 48 students. The recruitment selection was further followed up by the qualifying round and the PI round.

This workshop took place at the Chemistry Lab of the college with the help of YouTube while making sure that only the best techniques were imparted. They were quick to absorb the learning process and eventually became adept in the making of perfumes.

20). NSUT STALL

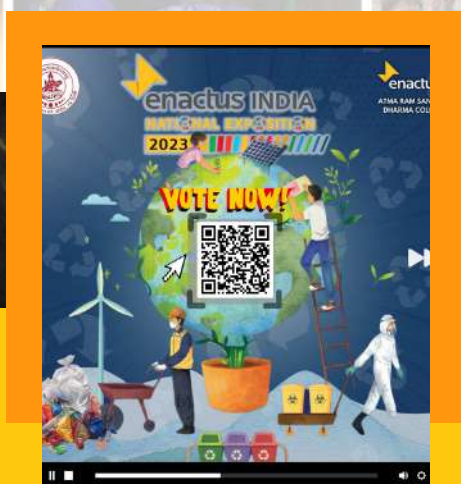

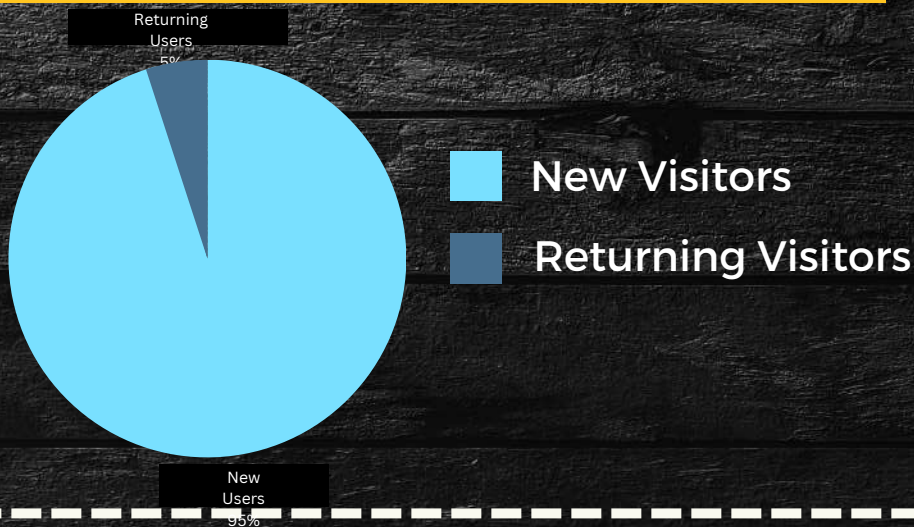

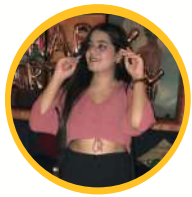

DIRECT IMPACT

Enactus ARSD's positive impact extends to communities, customers, and website visitors. Through initiatives like tree plantation and cleanliness drives, the organization actively engages with communities, supporting their businesses and fostering growth.

Project Kalakaari empowers underprivileged women, transforming them into successful entrepreneurs. The handmade products they create are sold through Enactus ARSD's stalls and e-commerce website.

Project Srijan has created new entrepreneurs who have successfully sold over 200 plants through social media platforms. Introducing products like terrariums and the jade plant has received a highly positive response from customers.

Enactus ARSD's Project Samvedna focuses on raising awareness about mental health, providing counseling and support to marginalized individuals. Through visits, donation drives, and the promotion of hand-painted t-shirts by LGBTQ artists, Samvedna has experienced significant growth in the last tenure.
