Dr.Manoj Kumar Pandey(lecturer in Economics, Australian National University) sailed us through the basics of STATA. We learned STATA's basic syntax , different rules , commands like summarise, tabulate, display etc. The session also covered topics like the linear fitting of data, rescaling of an axis, merging data sets, econometric analysis etc. Dr.Subhanil Choudhary (Asst.Prof. Institute of Development Studies, Kolkata) helped us understand R-STUDIO . We learnt about various topics like R-Objects, R as a vectorized language, substrings of a character vector, properties of data frame, loops, construction of functions, graphical analysis, OLS methods and much more. Overall it was a great learning opportunity for all members of FIC.

SESSIONS HELD DURING 2019-20

Session 1: Introductory session

The first session encompassed a detailed discussion on Guesstimation and a Case study, with the motive of acquainting members with the methods and modes of a Professional Interview.

Session 2: Finance Basics

This session was conducted to instill in students the importance of financial awareness and its application in the business world. Members were asked to examine the balance sheet and income statement of Dabur Co, one of India's largest MNCs, using its most recent annual report.

Session 3: Company Valuations

Members were introduced to the concept of cash flows, equity reports, and were challenged to predict a company's present value using the discounted cash factor method. Details on how to evaluate capital using the WACC method were discussed to make the session more interesting.

Session 4: Stock Markets

The session shed light on how a country's GDP (gross domestic product) and the entire economy are inextricably linked in a cause-and-effect relationship with stock markets, as well as how it deals with the fluctuations that are induced in it. Extensive discussions were held on Demat accounts, trading accounts, and how they are an essential means of assisting one to delve and advance in the world of stocks.

Session 5: MS Excel Session

The session began with a basic introduction to Excel and an explanation of the interface to a first-time user. The three-hour session also covered important Excel functions such as parenthesis, cell references, sorting and filtering, conditional formatting, using freeze panes, find and replace, paste special, pivot tables, cell anchoring, and beauty saving.

Session 6: Concluding Session

It involved examining a case study asked in the interview process of a leading consulting firm Mckinsey & Co. The session was used to analyze the situation and recommend a possible action route, the process of which included a thorough inspection of alternatives available and use that to reach conclusion and take decision .
