



Rules for candidates seeking Election to the Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College Students Union (2023-24). The details are mentioned below:-

- i) Candidates seeking Election to the ARSD College Students Union (2023-24) are required to submit a Demand Draft of Rs. 500/- (non-refundable) in the name of "**Student Societies Account**" payable at New Delhi (**Please write by Pencil** at the back side of D.D (1) Name of candidate, (2) Contesting Post, (3) Class & year, (4) Roll No. and (5) Mobile No., along with Affidavit of Rs. 10/- as per (**Annexure-I**)
- ii) Age relaxation of 03 years shall be given to the UG candidates from 22 years to 25 years and PG candidates from 25 years to 28 years (age as on 16.08.2023)
- iii) The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidate failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
- iv) The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University or 75 % attendance, whichever is higher.
- v) The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post.
- vi) Every candidate is required to furnish an affidavit - (**Annexure-I**)
 - A. That he/she does not have any previous criminal record and has not been subjected to any disciplinary action by the University/College.
 - B. That he has not failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current year
- viii) The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs. 5,000/-.
- ix) The candidate within two weeks of the declaration of the result submit complete and audited accounts to the College authorities.
- x) No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) students.
- xi) No candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the University/College/institute Campus including the website and Facebook page of the University College Institute for any purpose for any destruction/defacing of any University/College property.
- xii) The Hon'ble Supreme Court has made the provisions contained in Section 153A and Chapter IX-A "Offences relating to election" applicable to students election. Objectionable incidents, therefore, must be reported to the police, within 12 hours after the alleged commission of offence, for registering cases under relevant Sections of IPC.
- xiii) During the period of the elections no person, who is not a student on the rolls of the college university, shall be permitted to take part in the election process in any capacity. Any person, candidate, or member of the student organisation, violating this rule shall be subject to disciplinary proceedings, in addition to the candidature, as the case may be being revoked.
- xiv) The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the College University authorities.
- xv) First year students are eligible for contesting for the posts of Central Council only.
- xvi) The candidate must be a regular, full-time student of the college/university and should not be a distance/proximate education student. That is to say that all eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full-time course, the course duration being at least one year.
- xvii) Notwithstanding anything contained in the aforesaid code of conduct, the directives of the Supreme Court judgment dated 22.09.2006 shall prevail.
- xviii) The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of non-compliance with any of the above rules/guidelines.
- xix) The candidate has to declare:-
 - (a) I declare that I have never contested for any post of the student's union at my stay in the college from _____.
 - (b) I will not indulge in the disruption of classes in any way and abide by the rule of the College.
